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One-Month Exploration of South Island February 23 – March 23

General Plan

- Head south from Te Anau on SH99, seeing the few remaining sights in Fiordland (p. 408-431) we haven't already seen
- Head to the Southland (p. 432-447) on SH92 (Southern Scenic Route) and hang out in the Catlins for awhile
- Explore Otago (p. 366-407) other than Queenstown (e.g., Wanaka), following SH8 North
- Head to the West Coast (p. 344-365) on SH6 North, driving up the West Coast Highway (SH6 North) to Punakaiki
- Backtrack and cut over to Arthur's Pass on SH73 East to explore a bit more of Canterbury (p. 313-343)
- Head up the east coast on SH1 North to **Marlborough Sounds** (p. 266-312), visiting Kaikoura and Blenham on the way to Hopewell BP Lodge (3/23-3/24). On 3/25, drive to Marahau, starting point for the Abel Tasman Coastal Track.

Fiordland

- Borland Road (p. 426) and Borland Lodge (cabins) for possible stayover.
- Southern Scenic Route SH92 Tuatapere to Riverton (p. 425). Mores Coastal Loop Track (2 hr RT) (p. 430). Possible stayover in Riverton

Southland

- Hang out in the Catlins for awhile, driving from Kaka Point to Slope Point. Enjoy top-notch backpackers in Purakaunui (Falls Backpackers, p. 439), Papatowai (Hilltop Backpackers, p. 439), and/or Curio Bay (Curio Bay Backpackers, p. 440)
- See Cathedral Caves (p. 440) and Surat Bay (p. 438)

<u>Otago</u>

- See Wanaka (p. 396) listing of day hikes on p. 403
- Hike part of Otago Central Rail Trail (p. 373) if time permits

West Coast

- Drive West Coast Highway (SH6) from Westport to Haast
- See Pancake Rocks/blowholes in Punakaiki
- Stop in Okarito and Haast for hiking/kayaking opportunities
- Hike Franz Josef and Fox Glaciers

Canterbury

- Day hikes in the Southern Alps at Arthur's Pass (p. 334)
- Visit Lake Tekapo (p. 338) and Aoraki / Mt. Cook National Park (p. 340) side trip from SH8 North, time permitting

Marlborough and Nelson

- Kaikura (p. 279) Swim with dolphins (Dolphin Encounters, www.dolphin.co.nz)and seals (www.sealswimkaikoura.co.nz); visit the seal colony on the Peninsula Walkway (1½ hr). Other possibilities: albatross tours; sea kayak rentals.
- Blenham (p. 277) wine tasting and food; tour wineries by bike
- Nelson (p. 286) visit after Abel Tasman on the way to Picton (partial day visit; no must-see sights)
